The bathroom is a space of relief; momentarily liberated from life's social expectations and responsibilities, one can usually find refuge in this room. The idea that refuge could be so precisely and commonly located prompted me to photograph the corners of various bathrooms for several months. I was acutely aware of my environment when making these images, as cameras tend to be unwelcome within the realm of private space; my attempt to capture the boundaries that define this physical place of sanctuary resulted in my violating the conditions of its protection.

Intended to be printed on adhesive vinyl and placed on a floor, these images are meant to be stepped on, passed over, noticed, and reconsidered. Gazing downward, viewers may feel compelled to reevaluate an often disregarded element of their mundane spatial experience.
